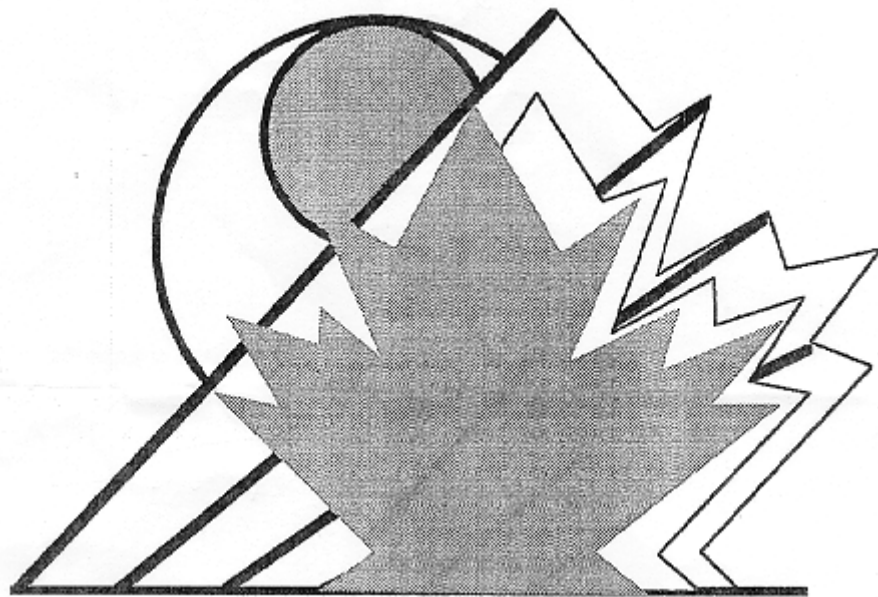

On behalf of the Canada JKA Karate Federation (CJFKF), I warmly invite you to our 7th annual Koyo Camp, hosted again this year by the Ottawa JKA and held in our nation's capital from September 17<sup>th</sup> to 21<sup>st</sup>.

Feedback from the last year's event was exceptional, and we aim to make the 7th annual Koyo Camp even better. We are privileged to have the renowned **Master Tanaka** return as the **featured guest instructor** and lead all black belts in specialized, advanced training. Assisting **Master Tanaka** again this year and working closely with all coloured belts will be Sensei Nemoto and Sensei Saeki. Note that Sensei Nemoto will continue to build on what is learned at the camp when he visits dojos across the country afterwards.

I am proud to announce that the 7th annual Koyo Camp is also the occasion of the first national championships. The tournament is open only to individuals who register for and attend all of the camp training sessions. Based on the results of the tournament, karatekas will be selected to be CJFKF finalists who will compete for a position on the national team to represent Canada at the Gichin Funakoshi Cup in Tokyo, Japan in 2009.

As well, Master Tanaka, Sensei Nemoto and Sensei Saeki will conduct JKA-certified sandan examinations and yondan-level re-examinations. Please see the registration form for details.

**All participants must register by July 31, 2008 and pay in Canadian funds. As banquet seating is limited, with only 195 tickets available, you must reserve early if you plan to attend.**

Each year, we eagerly look forward to seeing many new faces at Koyo Camp. We encourage all of your students, as well as all CJFKF members, to participate and celebrate with us the high standard of JKA karate here in Canada.

## General Information

### Registration

All participants must pre-register **with payment \$50 CDN non-refundable deposit to Ottawa JKA** no later than **July 31<sup>st</sup>**. The remaining **balance (CDN) is due by August 31<sup>st</sup>**. A list of all participants will be given to the Koyo Camp organizers to enforce this policy. On-site registration **is not** an option.

### Accommodations

Accommodations for Koyo Camp participants are available at Albert at Bay Suite Hotel which is one block from the training location. Full One Bedroom (2 Double Beds) and One Bedroom (1 Queen Bed w/Pullout Bed) Suites are available on a first come first serve basis at a rate of \$131 CDN with a charge of \$10 CDN for each additional person (up to a maximum of 4) a night plus applicable taxes. Those who register and/or pay after July 31<sup>st</sup> or those who attend selected classes can purchase extra banquet tickets for \$42.50 CDN. Seating is very limited. 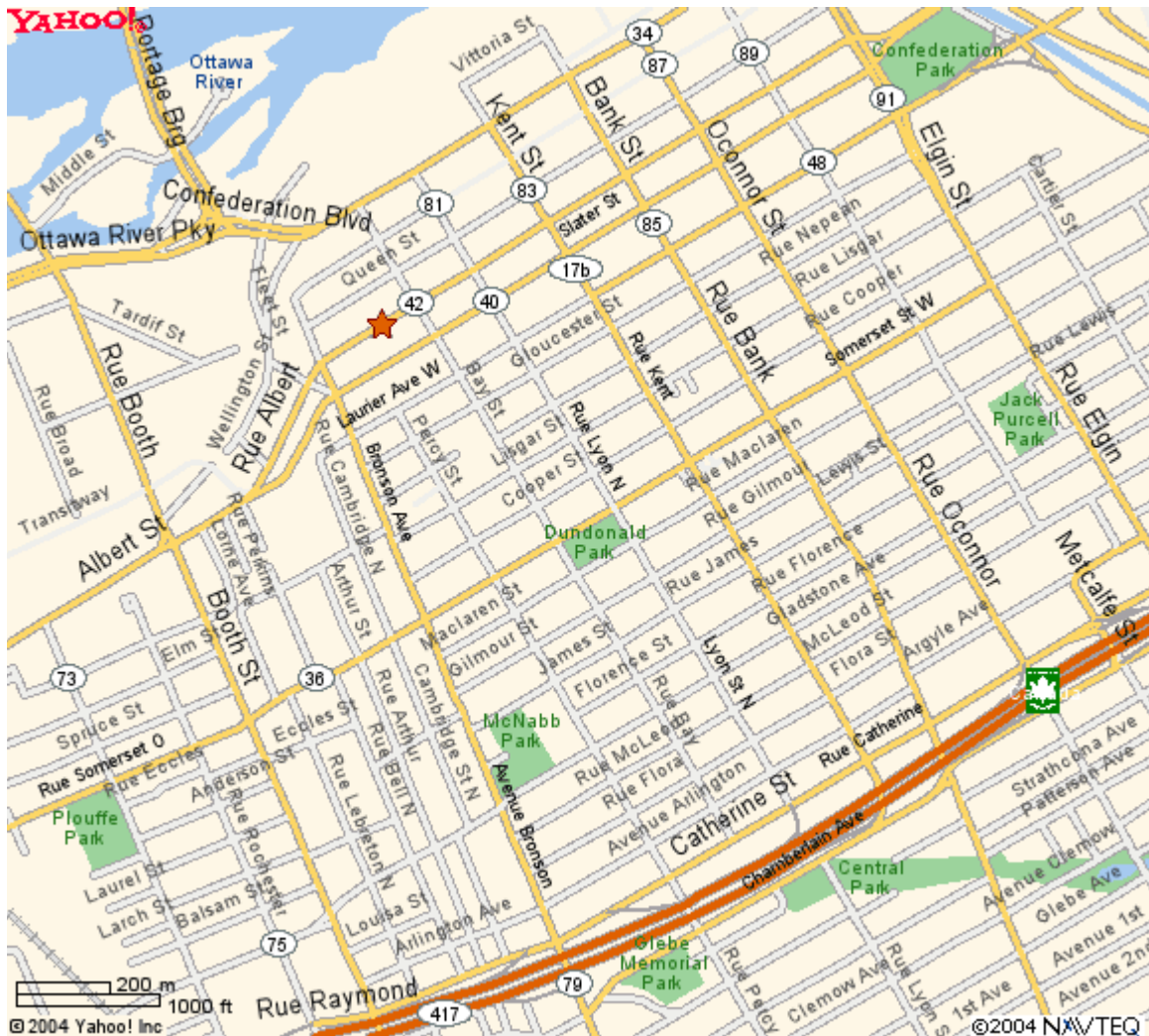

### **Albert at Bay Suite Hotel**

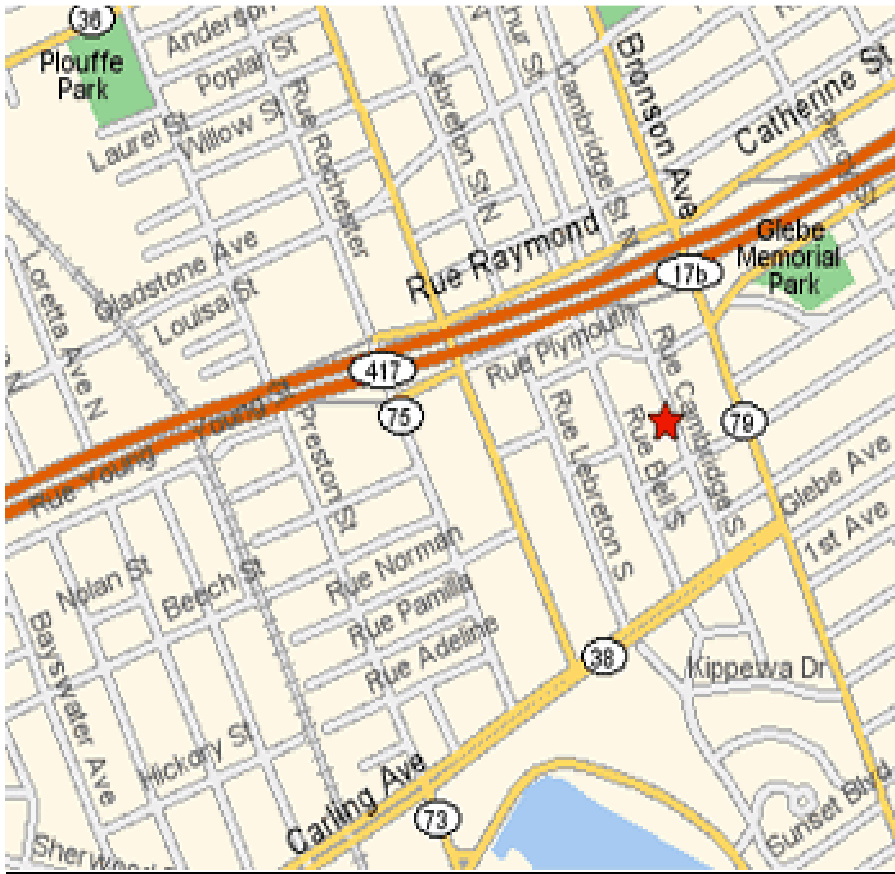
435 Albert Street, Ottawa, Ontario (at the corner of Albert Street and Bay Street)
